The building block set with the tank also carried other heroes of the Great War. They were medics and relief dogs who searched for the wounded on the battlefields and provided them with medicine. In addition to the sensational imprints that mimicked the appearance of the uniform, the medic was also given the Red Cross flag. Mercy Dog has a distinctive imprint with a cross.
