Manufactured by Germany, it entered service in 1944 as an interceptor. Bombing and reconnaissance versions were also produced. It was called the Sturmvogel by German pilots and was known to the Allies as the Turbo. Due to its late entry into service, the aircraft played no significant role during the war. Messerschmitt's Me 262 scored 900 kills with losses of 100 aircraft. This aircraft is inspired by a model on display in the Deutsches Museum in Munich. It was piloted by Hans Guido Mutke, who reached Switzerland in the last days of the war, where he was interned. Years later, the plane returned to Germany as a major museum exhibit. Build a perfectly recreated legendary German jet plane from World War II with 390 COBI building blocks! This beautiful historic aircraft was designed with attention to detail. The blocks are covered with high-quality prints that will not wear out even with intensive use. The painting of the aircraft refers to a machine with a very rich past, which is now in the Munich Museum. At the controls of this extraordinary machine we can place a figure inspired by the pilot Hans Guido Mutke. According to unconfirmed reports, this pilot was able to cross the sound barrier for the first time! The whole set is completed with a brick base and a plate with the model name. This beautiful aircraft with display is a perfect gift idea for fans of aviation, history and technology. It is sure to satisfy picky collectors and young people fascinated by blocks.
