The Seven Years' War took place between 1756 and 1763 and all the military forces in Europe at the time took part. It was considered by many historians to be the first world war, as the fighting also took place in the colonies occupied by the Europeans. In North America in particular, the war, also known as the French and Indian War, pitted the French royal troops, along with many allied Indian tribes, against the British and American troops of the "Thirteen Colonies". Both armies immediately advanced with the aim of conquering and destroying the enemy's fortress and settlements. It was a very hard war, both because of the complexity of the place where the fighting took place and because of the ferocity of the attacks. The Peace of Paris reached in 1763 brought the war to an end, and with it the British position of control over North America began to strengthen steadily.
