Group 7 racing cars are two-seater racing cars for circuit racing and the Lola T70 is considered one of the most successful two-seater racing cars in England. The car with the number 15 is characterised by its chic grey-metallic look and is now owned by a private gentleman racer. The Lola T70 with the number 15 in 1:24 scale races around your Carrera race track in a cool metallic look. The first known version of the racing car was the Lola T70 Spyder, which was replaced in 1966 by the Lola T70 Mk II Spyder and from 1967 by the Lola Mk III Spyder. Like the original, the slot car was modelled true to detail and equipped with front and rear lights as well as brake lights. The car can be controlled digitally, but can also be used in analogue mode and can also be individually coded.
