

Senseless regulatory measures can be extremely humorous! Nothing is safe from Wehrli's organizing hand. The comedian dismantles a wide variety of pictures into their individual parts and meticulously piles up all the elements, or he sorts what was previously a mixed bag. A parking lot is given a color code and you only shop by color in the supermarket. A Beethoven score is tidled up as thoroughly as a picture by Egon Schiele, the map of Europe, like the Vienna subway map, breaks down into its simple individual parts. Naked table football and counted French fries, Wehrli turns our everyday life upside down and emphasizes our obsession with order. In this memory game, the table is cleared without pardon. After that, nothing is what it was before. Each of his fine tidying up orgies is a humorous surprise. The Swiss Ursus Wehrli, born in 1969, is left-handed, lateral thinker and trained typographer. He has been touring with Nadja Sieger since 1987 as the comedian duo Ursus & amp; Nadeschkin between Berlin, Basel and New York and has received several awards in this constellation. He is known as Mr. Wehrli in the show with the mouse. He got the idea to clean up art when he was surprised at the beginning of winter while getting bread one morning and his ears were cold.
