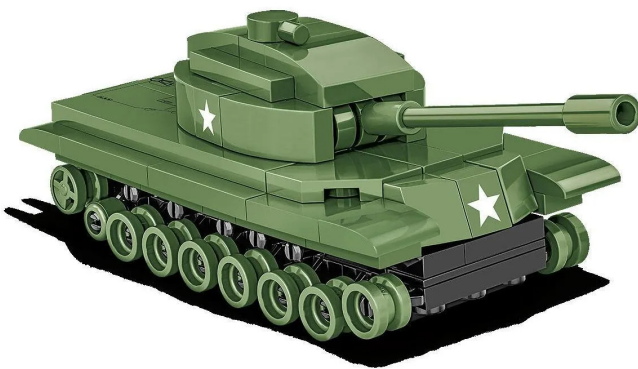

The miniature model made from COBI building blocks was designed in 1:72 scale and consists of 127 high-quality elements. When built, the tank is 12 cm long. Despite its compact size, the model retains all the important features of its historical role model! American markings are printed on the sides of the vehicle. The turret of the tank is movable and can be rotated. The barrel moves in the up-down direction. The model is perfect for a good start to your adventure with COBI building blocks. Patton is also an interesting model and gadget for collectors. It takes up little space and easily finds its place on the desk at home, at work or on the bookshelf.
