The equestrian warriors of Palmyramis prefer a lance called Mashiq and the curved equestrian saber Bin-Kalish.

The armory of the kingdom of thorns shows many typical weapons, armor and other pieces of equipment as well as unique artifacts from Arania and the perished Moghulate Oron in words and pictures. In the armory there are also numerous Aran weapons with a long tradition, such as the anchopal silver star, which is carried by many thieves who like phex, the Mendlicum stinging hammer, the weapon of the Babur warriors, and the curved Zorgan dagger, the first choice for every assassin. In addition to weapons, the armaments of the Aranians, such as the mirror armor or the Baburiner ring armor, are also to be found in the armory. In addition, weapons and armor of the Oronis and unique pieces, such as the amethyst lioness and talismans of the twelve divine churches, such as Phexen's throwing star, are described.

The volume also contains a ready-to-play description of an office of the Mada Basari including an attached caravanserai , where the heroes can shop and spend the night. This volume supplements the regional game aid Das Dornenreich with more extensive and generally applicable rules for the special objects of the region. Knowledge of the rules and the Aventurian Almanac is required.
