The volume includes a survey of the powerful carmal talismans kept in the region and introduces some of the dangerous magical artefacts kept in the hoard of the Emperor Dragon Shafir the Magnificent. An entire chapter is devoted to the famous forging skills of the Cyclopes, the children of the god Ingerimm, for every Aventurian adventurer dreams of once holding one of the legendary Cyclopean weapons in his
