Due to its design, a maximum speed of 35 knots and a long range were possible. During the Pearl Harbor attack in December 1941, her seaplanes conducted pre-attack reconnaissance over Pearl Harbor, which contributed significantly to the IJN's success in the operation. During the Battle of Leyte Gulf in October 1944, she was the flagship of Admiral Kurita's fleet and contributed to the sinking of the USS Gambier Bay, but was damaged by torpedoes and sunk off the coast of Samar Island.
