The car was perfectly simplified, economical and made it possible to comfortably transport four people with luggage. Christened the ugliest car in the world at the 1948 Paris Motor Show, it became an object of desire, contrary to the opinion of critics. During its 41 years of production, almost 4 million units were manufactured in factories all over the world.
